Mr Ian Wilson made contact with HF MIR 22/2/06 asking to speak with me. I was regrettably on RD. I phoned Mr Wilson on Code A but met with no reply on 2 occasions. At 1150 Mr Wilson answered his phone.

He asked a number of questions regarding the investigation, primarily around expert witnesses. I provided an update to the point I thought was appropriate. I informed him that my reticence to give information hinged on maintaining the integrity of the case. I informed him that we were working with all due diligence but things have to take the time they take. He asked about getting sight of the expert evidence under FOI. I pointed out that that was unlikely as the investigation was ongoing. He said he was losing faith with us. I indicated that I thought that was unfortunate as we are all working very hard to advance the investigation in the way we said we would. By the end of our conversation Mr Wilson seemed reassured as to our investigation but clearly frustrated that I could not answer his questions.

He concluded by saying that he had been, with others, this morning, with the IPCC discussing the Jon James complaint. After that he has spoken to the media. He said that through his frustration he said thing about the Rochester investigation but meant them to be directed at the former investigation but implied that they may adversely reflect on the present investigation.

I informed Mr Wilson that a FGM letter is due soon and would be delivered by the FLO Code A
