Please can you check if the following were available to patients at GWMH for the time period covering all of the patients?

1. Venflons and giving sets for intravenous infusions?
2. Bags of saline/ 5% dextrose for intravenous infusions?
3. Oxygen?
4. An ECG machine?
5. Could blood transfusions be given at GWMH?
6. Could intravenous antibiotics be given at GWMH?
7. Was GWMH set up to cope with all common medical emergencies that may develop in their patients?
8. if not, was emergency transfer to QAH possible 24h a day, 7 days a week?
9. Were there protocols/guidelines for the types of medical problems for which patients would be transferred from GWMH back to QAH for, e.g. gastro-intestinal haemorrhage, suspected myocardial infarction etc.
