>Following my e mail a few moments ago to Matthew Lohn, I recieved a
 >telephone call from him. He was concerned to confirm that my
 >recollection of our conversation was as I had described in the message
 >and not as the impression given in his message to me.

>He is clear that he does not act for the GMC in this, but attended the
 >meeting to discuss the issue generally.

>He makes the point that we are one of a number of Forces who are taking
 >the same stance (might be an idea to find out who they are & liase with
 >them to identify common cause).

>As we have discussed, the issue does need to be resolved and if this is
 >by way of judicial review, I would be content with that - I articulated
 >this to Matthew.

>A concern that Matthew has that he would ethically not be able to act for
 >us in any dispute over this issue, given his close professional
 >relationship with the GMC, this is understandable. I told Matthew that
 >I would be content if he did not advise or represent us over this matter
 >if it develops, but that he continue in the role he was engaged for,
 >that of QA review of the cases in question.

>He will discuss all this with you in your meeting on 9/6.
