

Sequence of events – data extracted from Complaint file – no data added from Operation Rochester

29 th July 1998	Mrs Richards falls and fractures femur Taken to Haslar Hospital
11 th August 1998	Mrs Richards transferred to GWMH
13 th August 1998	Mrs Richards fell whilst at GWMH
14 th August 1998	Mrs Richards transferred to Haslar Hospital
17 th August 1998	Mrs Richards transferred to GWMH
18 th August 1998	Mrs Richards administered diamorphine through a syringe driver
21 st August 1998	Mrs Richards dies at GWMH
27 th September 1998	Mrs MacKenzie alleges to Gosport Police that her mother Mrs Richards was unlawfully killed at GWMH
20 th November 1998	Mrs MacKenzie sends letter making complaint against DC Code A and DI MORGAN
10 th December 1998	Complaint acknowledged by PSD (Enquiry still continuing – outcome awaited)
25 th March 1999	Enquiry had been concluded and CPS had advised NFA (During this time file had been submitted twice as on the first occasion no ‘independent’ medical evidence had been sought).
25 th March 1999	Insp Fuge (PSD) contacted Mrs MacKenzie and makes appointment to take statement of complaint
27 th April 1999	Statement of complaint taken by Insp Fuge
	Investigation carried out by Code A is reviewed by D/Supt LONGMAN
	Case conference held with Head of CID following D/Supt Longman’s review of the enquiry. DCI Burt tasked to undertake further work, particularly in relation to medical opinion. Enquiry conducted by DCI BURT commences.
20 th April 2000	Supt Stogden (now IO) contacts Mrs MacKenzie and discusses complaint. Agreed that the complaint would be investigated once the current enquiry being undertaken by DCI Burt had been completed.
23 rd June 2000	Supt Whiting (now IO) decides to investigate, despite the ongoing Police enquiry. Interviews officers and reports to the PCA
	PCA endorse Supt Whiting’s recommendations re Operational Advice for both officers
13 th March 2001	PCA write to Mrs MacKenzie advising of decision to give Operational Advice to the Officers.
26 th March 2001	Letter of apology sent to Mrs MacKenzie apologising to her.
3 rd January 2002	Gosport Police write to Mrs MacKenzie advising her that no action will be taken in respect of allegations made against her sister concerning the distribution of the effects of their late mother.
