Thank you for your email of the 25th April and I am sorry for the delay in replying but I have been out of the office a great deal over the last couple of weeks.

I appreciate the concerns you have expressed in the third paragraph of your email about the return to post of Ian Piper and Tony Horne. Unfortunately I am not fully in the picture as to the reasons for their suspension/transfer and/or the reason for their subsequent reinstatement. I think that the best thing to do initially would be to approach your local Community Health Council and ask them to meet with you and discuss these issues to see if they can recommend any particular way forward. I would be interested in hearing from you about that.

With regard to the situation about Jane Barton, in the event of there being any concerns about her, it is open to any patient of Jane Barton who believes that they have a valid ground for complaint ie. that she is in breach of her terms of service to make a written complaint to the Local Family Health Services Committee. I would suggest that your sister's neighbour proceeds along those lines if she is concerned. It is also open to anyone with a complaint to report the matter directly to the General Medical Council.

With regard to the case in Leeds, that is somewhat different insofar as the actual suspension is concerned.

I hope that this email answers your queries but please come back to me if you should have anything further.
