

- Terms of ref - Summer 2001 - concerns raised about use of medicine
- October 2001 - Chi - launched investigation into the management, provision and quality of health care.

Investigation - 5 interrelated parts:-

- ① review & analysis of range of documents specific to the care of older people at the trust (App A)
- ② analysis of views from 36 patients. (App B)
- ③ 5 day visit to Gosport Hospital → 59 staff interviewed (App C)
- ④ Interviews with relevant agencies & NHS organisation (App D)
- ⑤ Independent review clinical/nursing notes random sample patient's died April 2001 - Jan 2002 (E+f)

Background:-

Sept 91 - relative of — contacted police alleging mother had been unlawfully killed

Nov 98 + Feb 99 - docs referred to CPS.

March 99 - CPS insufficient evidence.

Aug 01 - CPS insufficient evidence to provide a realistic prosecute any staff.

March 01 - 11 other families raised concerns

4 deaths referred for expert opinion

Dec 01 - Two expert reports raised: very serious concerns regarding prescribing practice.

Feb 2002 - Police decide a more intensive police investigation was not appropriate.
