1. Out of Hours Dryad and Daedalus

- Contract due to end on 31st Dec 2002-11-01
- Fargo Doc's approached, response from Ron Swann cautiously optimistic. Meeting with members on the 6th. Will make contact following that.
- Healthcall approached, all managers on leave till 4th Nov.
- Approx call outs per week 4. (not previously recorded, now being monitored).
- Reasons for most recent calls over last month (out of hours transfer/haematemesis/seizure/high temperature/increasing paranoia).

2. Bed fund GP's

3. PHT transfers to Sultan
