I'm a little surprised to find that after three months of providing the service this is still being passed around. We seem no closer to agreeing what you want or how much it's worth. Rosemary - as this doubles the number of beds covered under our Dryad SLA, I propose a simple doubling of the contract value from £23k pa to £46k pa.
