

Dear Fiona

I am writing on behalf of the practice to negotiate our *Contract for Services* to cover Daedalus and Dryad Wards out-of-hours for the year 1 April 2002 to 31 March 2003. Historically we have been paid on the basis of Clinical Assistant sessions. My interview with Dr Luxton in January 2002 in connection with the CHI investigation led me to believe that we were being underpaid.

In addition recent interpretation of the law relating to the minimum wage implies that being on call is covered by the Minimum Wage Act. I appreciate that this does in fact cover *Contract of Services*. I have therefore used the minimum wage as a basis for negotiation for covering Daedalus and Dryad Wards out-of-hours. The calculations are as follows:

(1) Hours covered per week = 128 hours x 52 = 6,656

Minimum Wage £4.10 per hour = £27,289.60

(2) In addition there are 8 Bank Holidays per year which should be covered at double time ie £8.20 per hour.

 $8 \times 24 = 192 \times £8.20 = £1,574.00$

Total Contract Price = £28,864.00

I appreciate that for the Bank Holidays some of the hours are in fact covered by the previous calculation in item (1). The contract price would include time for all quarterly meetings with yourself and the consultant in elderly medicine (Dr Lord at present).

I would also like to make the following points:

- (1) The contract would run from 1 April 2002 for one year.
- (2) My partners are happy to continue to work on this basis.
- (3) If the CHI report which is due out in July 2002 makes any major recommendations regarding the contract or services provided then we would obviously have to take account of this.

I look forward to meeting you to discuss these proposals.
