1 Apologies for Absence

Ros Reid

2 Matters arising from previous meeting

Apologies were received from Major Rosie Bamford, RHH who was unable to attend this meeting.

AC updated the group on the position regarding Physiotherapy. The contract with Haslar was currently under performing, and Haslar had confirmed that they have spare capacity. The waiting times for physiotherapy at Haslar are currently less than that at GWMH.

A paper entitled 'An analysis on the use of GP Medical Beds 1994/95' produced by Professor Martin Severs was circulated (copy enclosed). Martin has agreed to attend the next meeting of the Gosport Medical Committee, detailing the findings outlined in the paper.

Withdrawal of the Community Night Nursing 'on-call' services

AC updated the group on the pilot of the above scheme. He stated that the initial funding for the project was £35000 of recurring monies. Since the pilot had been stopped, the monies had not disappeared, but had been put into the twilight nursing service. In order for the pilot to be rolled out to the rest of the District it would cost in the region of £78000, an additional £43,000. A bid had not been submitted to the Health Authority from Portsmouth HealthCare Trust (PHCT). As a result, PHCT had decided that the pilot could not continue. BC queried

whether a bid had actually been submitted to the Health Authority, as a letter he had received from PHCT implied that a bid had been submitted. AC confirmed that he was not aware of a bid having been submitted and suggested that if GPs wished to raise this matter with PHCT, they should write to Barbara Robinson at GWMH.

4 Paediatric Community nursing review

AC reported that PHCT were currently reviewing the role of "sick children's nurses" across the district, in conjunction with Portsmouth Hospital Trust (PHT). BC was concerned that the role of the Health Visitors had changed and combined with the current lack of provision in Gosport due to the loss of the above nurses, a gap was appearing in the service for children, especially those with a terminal illness. The document Promoting Child Health In The Community (April 1996) does not mention a role for the Health Visitor in relation to sick children. AC reported that he had raised this issue in a letter to Paula Turvey, dated February 1996, but agreed to write a further letter.

AC

5 Diagnostic Imaging

AC updated the group stating that a further audit was to be carried out and that as requested the GPs would not be sent a questionnaire. The department would be closed during July and August for refurbishment. Cover had yet be agreed, but several options were being discussed.

6 Day surgery audit

Discussion centred upon the need for an audit which would look at the potential increase/shift in workload from secondary to primary care caused by increasing proportion of day surgery, as apposed to inpatient work. The comparatively low rates of day case surgery carried out in Haslar, as compared to other hospitals, exacerbated the need to establish a baseline. This would enable early detection and quantification of a shift in workload to primary care which may result from Haslar increasing the proportion of day surgery carried out, which would bring them more in line with other hospitals.

Given that MAAG were in the process of carrying out a day surgery audit, concern was expressed that this was not duplicated. However, HJ agreed to speak to Charles Lewis and see whether the MAAG audit could be extended to cover Gosport, especially given the current situation.

7 Quarterly Haslar review meeting

HJ explained that as part of the Health Authority's reorganisation, he would now be taking the lead for contract monitoring with Haslar, although the formal contract negotiations would still be carried out by John Henly. It was agreed that copies of the notes from the quarterly review meeting held on 17 April would be circulated to each practice along with the notes from this meeting.

8 Portsmouth Hospitals Trust draft strategic plan

Nicola Hartley, Strategic Planning Manager (PHT) attended the meeting to speak on the Draft Strategic Plan for PHT. A final draft was to be produced by the end of June and a three month consultation period then followed. Four key objectives were then outlined:

- 1) Develop QA
- 2) Rationalise St Mary's Hospital into a "Community Hospital +"
- 3) Make use if the private finance initiative
- 4) Develop services in communities

Detailed discussion then followed which covered a number of issues ranging from concerns over adequate car parking at QA, lack of adequate and direct public transport from Gosport to QA, the current problem regarding obtaining patients' medical records whilst on the wards, the need for increased diagnostic facilities and concern over the apparent reduction in the bed complement from 1074 to 970.

NH thanked those present for their helpful views and hoped that many of the issues raised would be addressed in the revised document and this would then form the basis for further discussion with GPs across the entire district.

9 Cash-limited GMS funding update

AC reported that given the current financial position of the Health Authority, funding for GMS, staffing, computing and premises has been extremely tight this year. All staffing bids have been received and approved for this financial year and it was unlikely that their would be additional funds mid year. Funding for computing had been restricted to hardware and software maintenance, GP links and those practices who had followed the tender exercise throughout the programme. Again it was unlikely that there would be additional funding this year. Improvements to premises had been put on hold and until the mid year review of GMS funding has been carried out. All improvement grants received this year have been logged and will be considered later in the year.

CT reported that Penny Humphris was still in negotiations with the LMC over the future role of lead GPs and agreed to report back as soon as he became aware if the outcome.

AC and HJ updated the group on the reorganisation of the Health Authority, explaining that for the Fareham and Gosport Localities, HJ now had responsibility for purchaser issues, with AC assuming responsibility for provider issues. Issues concerning the purchase of services, for example from Haslar PHCT and PHT, should therefore be directed to HJ who can be contacted on 01329 829313, or 01705 835037. Issues concerning GPs as providers of services, should be directed to AC, who remains on his old telephone numbers.

Future meetings would therefore be organised by HJ and attended by both HJ and AC.

An Analysis on the Use of GP Medical Beds 1994/95

Professor M P Severs FRCP (28.1.96)

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1.0 Introduction

As part of the current review of medical services between Portsmouth HealthCare Trust and Portsmouth Hospitals Trust a wide range of issues emerged. One such issue was General Practitioner beds, in particular their present use and their potential for use in the future. I was asked to comment on the last full years data on admissions (April '94 until March '95). The following analysis is my own and not a reflection of the PHCT. The figures used are Appendix 1.

2.0 Bed Usage

The table below identifies admissions per bed as a method for reviewing bed use.

Comment:

There is a remarkably similar bed usage in general terms in

each geographical location.

3.0 Bed Distribution

There are two ways the distribution of beds could be assessed. Method I uses District Council Populations. Method 2 uses Neighbourhood Populations. Table 2 uses District Council Populations (Appendix 2). If the lowest bed rate were to be used and the local Health Commission wished for an equitable distribution of beds a situation as in Table 3 would emerge.

An alternative approach could be taken using 'Neighbourhood Population' (Appendix 3). The problem then arises with precise boundaries. I have made some pragmatic (?erroneous) decisions on neighbourhoods and Community Hospitals. This information is brought together on Table 4 overleaf.

Deciding on a figure for planning GP beds using these figures is more difficult but if you take the proposed catchment populations of GWMH, PCH, HWMH and EVCH and use existing bed numbers then the bed rate per 1000 population comes out at 0.32/1000 population and thus the potential GP bed numbers would be much the same as those given in Table 3 where a bed rate of 0.31/1000 population was used

Comments

- 1. Bed distribution in a global sense is inequitable with Fareham and Portsmouth missing out.
- 2. Bed distribution based on population need is inequitable even when GP beds are available. The figures show that the smaller the population served the higher the bed rate for that population.
- 3. The bed provision in Emsworth is very high and is likely to significantly squew practice compared with Gosport and Havant.
- 4. There appears to be some room for interpretation of 'catchment' populations served by Community Hospitals.

4.0 Age Profile

Originally the concept was that GP Community Hospital beds would have some role in the young chronic disability service as well as for acute mild severity illnesses. The age profile of the Community Hospital work is shown in Table 5.

Comments:

- 1. Community Hospital GP beds deal overwhelmingly with the elderly
- 2. The age mix in EVCH is different from the others.
- 3. There is little GP inpatient care of the young in GP beds.

5.0 Diagnostic Case Mix

The code descriptions are often so vague as to be worse than unhelpful eg Breast Unspecified, Part Unspecified etc. It is impossible to tell whether this is a 'Terming' problem of the GP's or a Coding problem within the PHCT. Given that there are several examples of very specific codes, I suspect the former issue dominates. The analysis of the case mix qualitatively reveals a very wide spread of diagnostic codes. I have therefore analysed case mix in 3 ways

- a) *Top Counts*; ie the three top diagnostic code prevalences for each Community Hospital.
- b) *Inappropriate counts*; ie conditions which should be managed in a DGH. For this exercise I have chosen acute myocardial infarction.
- c) Case Mix Selection; Given the age group one would expect patients with Dementia (all types) to be between 5 20% of casemix unless they were selectively admitted elsewhere.

a) Top Counts

In table 6 below I have tabulated the top 3 diagnostic codes for each Community Hospital. The figures in brackets are percentages of total admissions for that Community Hospital.

Comments

- 1. GP's appeared to use their beds for mild acute care, post acute care and social care.
- 2. Post Acute Care following surgery varies with the locality. Once again Emsworth stands out.
- 3. GP's appear to be using GP beds appropriately with very few acute MI's being admitted directly to Community Hospitals. The representation of dementia is inappropriately low for the population in question suggesting possible selection bias within the mild acute illness category.
- 4. A significant amount of the activity in GP Medical beds could be social care.

6.0 Source of Patients

Patients admitted to GP Medical beds come from either the community or transfer from DGH beds. The ones from the surgical wards appear to receive a code for 'Following Surgery'. Table 9 below shows the number and percentage of admissions from General Wards. 'Following Surgery' patients are a subset of the latter group.

Comments

- EVCH offers a district wide post surgical service to presumedly designated surgeons. I am unaware of any formal relationship or care path and thus this is presumedly historical
- 2. Apart from EVCH GP Medical beds overwhelmingly serve a local population.
- 3. GP medical beds offer a considerable service to Surgeons and Physicians in DGH hospitals. This post acute workload consumes approximately a quarter to a third of GP medical bed availability.

7.0 Scenario Planning

a) How many bed days would be available if GP's did not do Holiday Care?

The amount of holiday relief in absolute terms and the rate per district council catchment population is shown in Table 11. This would equate to 8 beds with a 90% bed occupancy being used per annum for holidays.

- Note there appears to be some sort of consistency of GP decision making for Holiday Relief as the pattern is remarkably consistent across the district
- b) If GP beds were available for Portsmouth residents and for Fareham residents what would the bed saving be for the DGH Hospital sectors?

Table 12 shows the bed days utilised in GP medical beds that exist for patients admitted from 'Other NHS Hospitals' and the subset of 'Post Surgical' patients

Comments

The bed days occupied by transfers vary considerably in each locality. It is unknown whether this is a reflection of patient choice by the referring consultant, acceptance criteria of each Community Hospital or variations of GP practice.

To assess the impact of GP beds in Fareham and Portsmouth on DGH practice we would need two planning figures.

- a) An assessment of the bed days that would be utilised in the GP medical beds.
- and b) An understanding of the relationship between bed days saved in DGH's Vs bed days utilised in Community Hospitals.

Table 13 below captures (a). We have no idea of (b). The hospital side would say that the ratio would be low ie very few bed days saved in the DGH. However this is unlikely to be the case as the patients transferred are likely to be the ones not making a speedy enough recovery, and thus the ratio may be nearer to unity that at first thought.

In simple terms with a 90% Bed Occupancy GP Medical facilities for Portsmouth and Fareham could save about 22 Medical and Surgical DGH beds. Of which 10 are likely to be surgical, by post acute care in Community Hospitals.

8.0 Conclusion

The global distribution of GP Medical beds is inequitable. The largest populations are the ones not served. The distribution of the existing beds favours in numerical terms the smaller populations. GP Medical beds serve the local population unless numbers are excessive. In this situation the beds become used for post acute care through special relationships which appear to be with surgical specialties. GP Medical beds are used for 3 main purposes sub-acute care, post acute care and social care. The activity of the units is a feature of clinical case mix and bed availability. GP's appear not to admit inappropriately to their beds but may exclude groups which may benefit from a more local service.

The GP medical service forms a significant post acute service and should not be excluded from deliberations on the shape of services (both medical and surgical) especially in a primary care led NHS.

9.0 Recommendations

- 9.1 GP's and the Health Commission should establish whether they feel GP Medical Beds are a feature of Health provision in PSEH, and if so whether it should be equitably distributed.
- 9.2 GP's, the Health Commission and PHCT should establish whether they feel the current use of the GP Medical Beds namely sub-acute, post acute and social is the model they wish to continue with.
- 9.3 GP's and the Health Commission with local providers should establish whether GP Medical Beds have to be offered through Community Hospitals or whether other building or types of Hospital site could be utilised.
- 9.4 Before agreeing to reshape Medical services in PSEH GP's, Provider Trust's and the Health Commission should have a clear, explicit agreement on the role of GP medical beds in the 'Post Acute' domain.
- 9.5 Trusts, GP's and the Health Commission should make the 'Post Surgical Care' area more explicit and understandable, in the existing system.
- 9.6 In a needs led NHS in which primary care is the focus there is an apparent gap in linking GP Medical Bed Services to populations. This should be remedied.

- 9.7 The question of 'Holiday Relief' needs to be tackled by GP's, Social Services, the Health Commission and ?Department of Elderly Medicine such that there is a consistent delivery of health and social care across the district. No new GP inpatient services should be brought on stream until this is solved.
- 9.8 GP's either through MAAG or PHCT Audit Department or both should review terming and coding of GP Medical Admissions such that anomalies can be explained or removed.

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
