The Gosport Weekend Out of hours pilot

Background

Gps in Gosport in 1994/95 placed a bid before the Health Commission for a pilot project to trial a new weekend out of hours service for their patients, known as Gos Doc. Due to a number of reasons the pilot never progressed pass the discussion stage.

The present cover for general medical services is via five separate rotas.

- (1) Dr Anderson & Partners and Dr Pennells & Partners
- (2) Dr Knapman
- (3) Dr Askew & Partners and Dr Coonan & Partners
- (4) Dr Collins & Partners
- (5) Dr Lacey & Partners and Dr Hajiantonis & Partners

The Government and GMSC have recently come to an agreement over the issue of out hours, of which part of the agreement sets aside funding for alternative arrangements.

Proposal

To fund a month of weekend out of hours calls in Gosport. There would be a 32 GP rota covering approximately 70,000 patients. The service would consist of a nurse answering service, working to a protocol, based at Gosport War Memorial Hospital. All calls between 11.00am to 11.00pm on a Saturday and from 8.00am to 11.00pm on Sunday to the Gps on call, would be diverted to the nurse based at GWMH. She would be working in conjunction with the on call GPs. The patient could then be invited to attend at GWMH, the GP surgery or receive a home visit.

Based on the information from the trial, a decision will be made to either return to the present practice, or undertake to continue the new arrangements.

Funding

The full funding for the pilot will be sought from the Health Commission. If the pilot is successful and it is deemed to continue with the new arrangements, further funding from the Health Commission for the scheme at the 70% reimbursement rate will be sought until the end of the financial year. Once the funding arrangements under the GMSC and Department of Health agreement are know, a bid will be placed from this source. It is hoped that if the new scheme is undertaken, that by the end of the following financial year (1996/97), the full cost will be met by the GPs in the rota.

Benefits

The advantage of this rota for Gosport patients would be, a quickly answered phoned by a qualified nurse. A more flexible response to the visit request, particularly in busy periods when the volume of calls can be very heavy. A GP based at GWMH in casualty for most of the weekend daylight hours. An exclusively Gosport GP solution for the majority for weekend calls.

We held a meeting at Stoke Road on Thursday 30 November 1995 to discuss GOSDOC III.

Key points of the meeting were that there are 26 GPs interested in the 4 weekend trial rota. It was reiterated that the trial was indeed that, an experiment to see how it worked and did not commit any one to continuing with a weekend rota. It was decided that February would be when the trial takes place. The hours covered would be 12 mid-day on Saturday to 10 pm and 8 am on Sunday until 10 pm (by excluding the hours after 10 pm and before 8 am, there would be no need to exchange night visit fees).

The dedicated telephone lines in the Gosport War Memorial would be answered by a rota of GP receptionists. They would be paid time and a half on Saturdays and double time on Sundays. They would be paid on their existing salary scale. The receptionists would be recruited from within participating Practices, preferably at least one from each Practice. Shifts could be from 3 - 6 hours long.

Alex Clark said there would be one thousand pounds available from GMS money to pay the receptionists. This is separate money from the forty five million pounds out-of-hours Development Fund.

Three GPs would be on duty on each weekend day. They would do 3 shifts each per day. There would be a first on for visits shift, a surgery shift and a second on shift.

It was suggested that the second on (when not out on calls) would have the important job of being based at Casualty, advising patients if appropriate and persuading them to attend the GP surgeries.

As there are 26 GPs interested in the trial rota and only 24 needed for the trial, it was suggested that Dr Martin Asbridge and Dr David Young observed the workings and results of the trial without participating in the shifts. This also avoids large fluctuations in the population of patients covered by the trial rota. However, they would be welcome to join the rota if it carried on.

We agreed to meet again at Stoke Road at 7.30 pm on Monday 11 December 1995. In the meantime we would discuss the meeting with our partners and seek their permission to approach the receptionists and collect names of those interested in assisting with the February rota.

At the next meeting we intend to confirm everyones commitment to the trial as set out, report back regarding receptionists numbers, and construct a firm bid for the money required from the Health Commission. We will examine potential rotas for the Doctors in February, discuss problem areas and confirm with Trevor Abbott the details regarding telephone lines etc.

If there are any comments about these minutes, please fax me! Also if any one has a change of heart please let me know soon.

What we need is a good name for the rota, all suggestions will be welcome. Watch this space!
