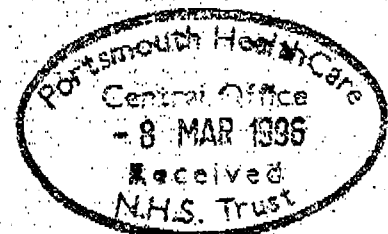

Thank you for your letter of 28 February 1996 regarding the above named.

The Council has also received correspondence from [Code A] about this matter. [Code A] has indicated that he is unhappy about the Trust's decision about Ms Jarman's conduct. It is not the Council's function to review disciplinary action taken by employers; the Council may only act in respect of specific allegations of misconduct against registered practitioners which are likely to lead to removal from the register. Our investigations and actions are entirely independent of any others and this will be made clear to [Code A]

In accordance with the Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors (Professional Conduct) Rules 1993, [Code A] case may be placed before the preliminary proceedings committee in due course. The members will decide whether any further action against the practitioner is necessary, with particular regard as to whether the matter may lead to removal from the register.

To assist the committee it would be helpful if you could let me know whether the witnesses, particularly [Code A] would be willing to make a statement to the Council's solicitor and to give evidence if necessary at a meeting of the Council's professional conduct committee.
