I am the outpatient services manager for the Gosport New Memorial Hospital, Bury Road Gosport Hants. I have held this position for the past six years.

I have the overall responsibility for the filing and security of all case notes stored at the hospital. This office is known as a districtwide records office. This means that we share records with Queen Alexandra Hospital, Haslem, St Mary's and also St James Hospital concerning mental health issues.

If a patient is first seen at Queen Alexandra Hospital then that patient's notes will be given a Q suffix and stored there even though they may go on to be treated at other hospitals.

If the notes were started at Gosport then they would have a suffix G, if at the Royal Hospital Haslem then R.H. at if at St Mary's then S. suffix.

This office has a policy that if a patient has not been seen by anyone for a period of 3 years or more then that person's records are transferred either to microfiche or microfilm.

I have been asked by Hampshire police to produce the complete medical records where available of 60 named patients who died or were treated at this hospital. In response to this request I have produced a spread sheet. This spread sheet shows the name
