Following our letter of 22nd September, 1998 the offer of a meeting was accepted and a date arranged. The Mrs. McKenzie postponed because she could not make set date and she volunteered (on 30th September, 1998) to arrange a new date with her sister, Mrs. Lack. This was the last we heard until the police phoned me. In other words, they never completed the complaints procedure.

We've had nothing in writing from the police. Code A explained to me that he was doing a very low key review to check/confirm that criminal proceedings were NOT applicable or necessary. He was seeking information to support his view that the issue was clinical judgement in terminal care rather than a criminal act.

Also enclosed is a copy of our letter to him which accompanied Dr. Lord's report. I'll be checking what's happening with him in the near future.
