Althea, I have not had any documents from the police about their enquiries - phone calls only. I sent you a memo yesterday outlining what I think we should do re. preparing a statement. The notes are on Dryad: I thought it best to leave them there for you on Monday, rather than them passing you in the post as you travel up and down to Gosport.

The police are trying to establish whether there is a question that Mrs Richard's may have been unlawfully killed because she was not given IV fluids during the time she was being given analgesia via a syringe driver.

To help you with your task, I've attached here a copy of our investigation report into the original complaint made by Code A and our subsequent letter to her. Please let me know if there is any more information you would find helpful.
