I've spoken to the police again today. DCI Ray Burt has left this case. The senior investigating officer is now Detective Superintendent John James - based in Portsmouth.

I spoke to John this afternoon, the only news is that he is trying arrange a meeting with the CPS for this week or early next week. He hopes that the decision will be known within a couple of more weeks.

He assured me that the arrangement made with Ray Burt still stand. What ever the decision, no action will be taken without the police alerting me first. They have not explored the other cases, from press stories yet. Waiting for CPS decision before doing so.
