Police are investigating the circumstances surrounding the death of a 91-year-old woman from Lee on Solent following a complaint by her family.

She died in August 1998 at the War Memorial Hospital in Gosport after being transferred there from Royal Hospital Haslar.

In line with patient confidentiality we cannot reveal the nature of her medical condition.

A team is now working from Fratton police station and when the investigation is complete a file will be sent to the Crown Prosecution Service.

We have the full co-operation of the Portsmouth HealthCare (NHS) Trust and the Royal Hospital Haslar for our investigation.

If asked further:

Who were the family members? Her two daughters

When was the complaint originally made by her family? The complaint by her family was originally made in September 1998.

Why investigate it now? A preliminary investigation was undertaken by police at the time and the CPS advised no further action. The case was reopened after further concerns were voiced by her family.

What is the allegation made by the family? We are looking into the circumstances surroundings her death to see if there are any criminal issues arising from it. If pushed: The allegation under investigation is that of unlawful killing.

How many officers are working on the case? A total of nine people, including civilian staff, are working on the investigation from Fratton police station.

Statement: re Gladys Richards

Mrs Richards died at Gosport War Memorial Hospital on August 21st, 1998.

She had been receiving care following readmission from Haslar Hospital. Mrs Richards had been transferred there following a fall at GWMH and a prior half-hip replacement operation at Haslar.

We understand Mrs Richards had, before this, suffered an initial fall at (do we wish to insert name or 'local'?) nursing home.
