In September 2000, the UKCC received information from Hampshire Constabulary relating to the death of a patient at Gosport War Memorial Hospital, Gladys Richards. This was based on an expert report into Mrs Richards' death commissioned for the police by Professor Livesley. Your name, together with a number of other nurses, appeared within the complaint although no specific allegation was made against you.

In September 2001, the UKCC's Preliminary Proceedings Committee considered the matter and declined to proceed with the case.

The purpose in my writing to you is to confirm that while, as has been reported, the Nursing and Midwifery Council is considering a number of complaints against registered nurses who had worked at Gosport War Memorial Hospital, there is no outstanding complaint against you.

I notice, moreover, that your registration lapsed at the end of August 2008 and that you have opted not to practise.
