Further to my statement made to the Police on 21st February 2003 (21/02/2003) regarding the Gosport War Memorial Hospital I would like to state the following. I have today Wednesday 1st June 2005 (01/06/2005) read my previous statement made and also a copy of Exhibit TJS/1. I have been asked to clarify the following point: On page 4 paragraph 3 of my signed statement I have stated "They told me that they felt the matter had been sorted out. Anita said that things had changed for a short period of time as patients didn't appear to be automatically put on diamorphine".

On Exhibit TJS/1 which I typed up myself regarding the telephone conversation at 1700 on 10th September 2002, I have stated "Both felt nothing had been sorted, although Anita said that things had changed for a short period, as patients didn't appear to automatically be put on diamorphine". I can see the discrepancy in the two accounts. But after all this time I cannot recall specifically what I said. I can concede that I may have made an error in my typing up of the telephone conversation.

However, I feel that I was told that things had been sorted out at the time and that things did change for a short period. I can make no further assumptions on this matter because I cannot remember that far back.
