Thank you for returning your reply to Coroner's Jury Summons. I am writing to confirm that you are required to report for Jury Service at the time, date and place shown above. A map is enclosed showing the location of the Portsmouth Combined Courts building. It is anticipated that the Coroner will require you to serve on his Jury for six weeks.

I am enclosing a Certificate of Financial Loss. This needs to be completed by your employer if you will not be paid during your Jury Service. Compensation for your loss of earnings cannot be made without proof from your employer of the amount that will be deducted from your earnings while you are serving on the Coroner's Jury. It would helpful to the Coroner if your employer could complete and return the form in the enclosed envelope before your Jury Service. Reimbursement of your financial loss will be made weekly after submission of the expenses claim form as outlined below.

An expenses claim form for the first week of your Jury service is also enclosed. The form outlines the maximum amounts that you can claim. Please complete the claim form after the first week of your Jury service and hand it to the Coroner's Officer at the Court on Monday morning, 23 March. It will help car users to make a note of the number of miles travelled to and from the court. Wherever possible, please provide receipts or tickets for car park, public transport fares or refreshments. Please note that reimbursement of fares will not exceed public transport rates.

All your expenses will be paid weekly in arrears and expenses claims forms for subsequent weeks will be handed to you each Monday. These should be submitted the following Monday for payment.

The Coroner's Officer at the Court will be unable to answer queries about your expenses. My telephone number and email address is shown below and I will be pleased to give any assistance you may need.
