

RE: GOSPORT WAR MEMORIAL - INQUEST -- MRS EVA PAGE


I understand that a Coroner's Inquest is to be held to investigate the cause of death of ten patients who died at Gosport War Memorial Hospital.

My mother, Mrs Eva Page, was a patient in the hospital and her case is presently to be presented to the General Medical Council (GMC) Fitness to Practice Hearing against Dr Jane Barton.

A letter received today from the solicitors bringing the case against Dr Barton, informs me that this hearing will be put back until the result of your inquiry is made.

The letter also informs me that eight of the cases to be used in the GMC hearing form part of the Coroner's Inquiry.

I would like to know if my mother's case is one of the cases to be used in your inquiry, if so, would I receive information to this affect and details of the time and place of the court hearing..
