The ten cases that we need to examine are:-

- Lesley PITTOCK who died when he was 82years old having been admitted to Gosport on 5th January suffering from Parkinsons Disease. He died in Gosport War Memorial Hospital on 24th January 1996 with the cause of his death being said to be Bronchopneumonia.
- 2 Elsie LAVENDER was 83years old and was admitted to Gosport War Memorial Hospital on 22nd February 1996 with what was said to be head injury/brain stem stroke. She had continued pain around the shoulders and arms. She died on 6th March 1996 with the cause of death being given as Cerebrovascular Accident or Stroke.
- 3. Helena SERVICE was aged 99yrs and was admitted to Gosport on the 3rd June 1997 with numerous medical problems, diabetes, congestive cardiac failure, confusion, sore skin and she died on 5th June 1997 the cause of death being given as Congestive Cardiac Failure.
- 4. Ruby LAKE was 84years old and was admitted to Gosport on 18th August 1998 with a fractured neck of femur, diarrhoea, atrial fibrillation, ischaemic heart disease, dehydration and leg/buttock ulcers. She died on 21st August 1998 and the cause of death was given as Bronchopneumonia.
- Arthur CUNNINGHAM was aged 79yrs and was admitted to Gosport on 21st September 1998 with parkinsons disease and dementia. He died on 26th September 1998 with the cause of death being given as Bronchopneumonia.
- 6. Robert WILSON was aged 74yrs and was admitted to Gosport on 14th October 1998 with a fractured left humerus and alcoholic hepatitis. He died on 18th October 1998 with a cause of death given as congestive cardiac failure and renal/liver failure.
- Enid SPURGIN was aged 92 and was admitted to Gosport on 26th March 1999 with a fractured neck of femur. She died on 13th April 1998 with the cause of death being recorded as Cerebrovascular Accident or Stroke.
- Geoffrey PACKMAN was aged 66yrs and was admitted to Gosport on 23rd August 1999 suffering from morbid obesity, cellulitis, arthritis, immobility and pressure sores. He died on 3rd September 1999 with the cause of death recorded as Myocardial Infarction or Heart Attack.
- 9. Elsie DEVINE was 88years of age and was admitted to Gosport on 21st October having being diagnosed with multi infarct dementia and moderate to chronic renal failure. She died on 21st November 1999 with the cause of death being given as Bronchopneumonia and Glomerulonephritis.
- 10. Sheila GREGORY was aged 91yrs and was admitted to Gosport on 3rd September 1999 with a fractured neck of femur, hypothyroidism, asthma and cardiac failure. She died on 22nd November 1999 with the cause of death being given as bronchopneumonia.
