I acknowledge receipt of your letter dated 7th. November re. expenses, overnight stay etc.

The inquest will be for two weeks and I am down for half a day — until I hear the evidence how can I ask questions about it? I have booked myself into a disabled Centre for the whole two weeks — it will not amount to £69.20 for the whole period but there will be train fares from Eastbourne at the weekend. and return , plus Ferry crossings and bus fares from accommodation between Fareham, Gosport and Portsmouth — I cannot commute from Eastbourne every day . I would not expect the Inquest to cover "refreshments " although I could get a M & S sandwich for the £2.40 allowed. Presumably your letter is a stock letter without taking into consideration number of witnesses. In addition I note you state the inquest will be held in the Coroner's Court in the Guildhall. As of the 31st. October preinquest there is some doubt as to where it will be held — the last thing mentioned was that Mr. Horsley would try and get a room in the Guildhall — if it is now in the Coroner's Court I am much relieved as" a room" in the Guildhall does not take into account the considerable Press interest plus the 80 other families, some of whom did not have the opportunity to make a statement to the Police or even have a hearing at the GMC.

I would be grateful if you could clarify the situation with the Coroner. Gillian M Mackenzie
