Research has revealed – yes there were complaints – upheld by investigation by Essex police and Avon and Somerset Constabulary – one detective inspector given two cautions and a second reprimanded after a misconduct tribunal. This of course is not the case with Hampshire Constabulary – my first complaint was suppressed until I went over the head of the Professional Standard office so a decision was not taken by the PCA for three years and in the other complaint the Police Officer was promoted and left the Police Force for the second time before the IPCC could make their decision. Their decision was not made due to the delays experienced trying to obtain an interview with Deputy Chief Constable Readhead (PCA) who then had to pass it over to the newly formed IPCC.
