I refer to my letter of the 1 December and I wonder if you are yet in a position to reply?

I have spoken to DS Roy Stevenson and arrangements are in hand to transfer the original medical records and the drug register back to the NHS. I would of course advise that they should be made available to any other Interested Party upon request.
