You've got it totally right. The discharge figures include deaths. The difference is the patients who are either still Inpatients or not recorded as being discharged. This difference will include patients who have been transferred to wards other than Daedalus, Dryad or Sultan and discharged from there

Dear Ms Stockley

Can I check my understanding of the figures, I need to be absolutely certain I have got it right. Is it right that the discharges include deaths? Thus, for Daedalus over the entire period, there were 1028 admissions. 990 of these have been discharged, of whom 332 were deaths. 38 (1028-990) are either still inpatients or have not been formally discharged.

For Dryad ward, on this basis, there were 679 admissions, with 647 discharged (this figure includes 314 deaths), leaving 32 either still on the ward or not recorded as discharged.

For Sultan, there were 3109 admissions, with 2966 discharged (this includes 461 who died), leaving 143 unaccounted for.

The other way of interpreting the figures would be that there were 1028 admissions to Daedalus, with 990 discharged and 332 deaths - but this would mean that 1322 people had either died or been discharged, when only 1028 had been admitted. The same would apply for the other wards - an excess of discharges and deaths over admissions.
