Subject: Coroner's Inquests - update

Dear All

Last night on BBC South Today there was an item regarding a private meeting between the families of the ten patients who died and the coroner. They said that this was a meeting to sort out the 'nuts and bolts' of what was to happen, which are:

- The inquests will start in March 2009
- 2. They will take place in either Portsmouth or Fareham
- About 20 witnesses will be called
- They will last about six weeks
- 5. Not a criminal investigation
- 6. There will be a jury who can return verdicts ranging from an open verdict to unlawful killing.

It may be that this meeting was the pre-meeting that we were told was to take place in August, and that we were not to be involved at all.
