The Dr Jane Barton inquest is due to resume again on Monday (18th January), where the GMC fitness to practice panel which is considering the case will reconvene. They are planning that the first two days will be for reading only, with the first public session due to begin on Wednesday (20th January).

We have had significant press interest in the case so far, but there is a chance that you may be approached by journalists to provide comment on the case.
